- B) Masters in Islamic Finance Practice entry requirements:
 - a. Candidate must have a recognised Bachelor's Degree from a university recognised by INCIFF
 - b. Candidate must obtain minimum CGPA of 2.5 or above.
- C) PhD in Islamic Finance:
 - a. Masters degree or equivalent (with high distinction) from a recognised institution of higher learning with minimum CGPA of 3.5 or above.
 - b. Demonstrate proficiency in Mathematics / Quantitative Analysis.
- "All candidates must demonstrate English proficiency through either of the following:
 - Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a score of pbt 550, ibt 79 or cbt 213; or
 - International English Language Testing System (IELTS) level 6.
